

SHOWER CURTAIN COVER

Ready Made



Materials

- Fabric (approximately 72" x 72")
- Waterproof shower curtain liner
- Shower curtain rings

Tools

- Sewing machine and thread
- Scissors
- Pins
- Iron and ironing board
- Grommet puncher and grommets (hole size at least 1/2" in diameter)

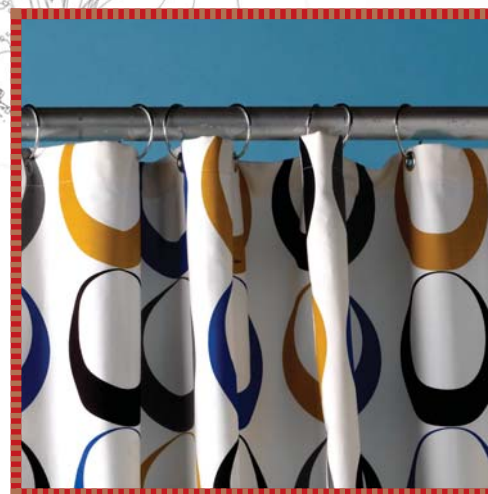
Cutting

1. Here's how to put together your 72" x 72" piece of fabric for the shower curtain. Basically, the finished piece is 2 yards wide by 2 yards long.
2. For fabric 45" or 60" in width, start with 4 yards of fabric. Cut the yardage in half, so that you have 2 pieces each 2 yards long, and sew together down one of the long edges. The length will be equal to 2 yards, or 72", but the width will be longer; measure the width to 2 yards or 72" and cut off the extra. Begin by folding a 1/2" hem on

the right and left sides of your fabric, then fold over again and press hems flat with a steamy iron. For the top and bottom edges, fold a 1" hem and then double over and pin around the entire piece of fabric so no raw edges are exposed. Again press hems flat.

Sewing

3. Sew down your hems 1/4" in from the unfolded edge on all sides of the curtain.
4. Holding the top of the curtain up to the liner again, use a pencil to lightly mark where the holes for the curtain rings will go.
5. With your scissors, cut a small hole at each marking, about 1/2" to 3/4" in diameter.
6. Place the two corresponding grommet pieces on either side of the hole in the fabric, and seal together with the grommet puncher. Press hard to make a secure bond! Repeat for all the other ring holes.
7. Insert rings, hang it up and get ready for your curtain call!



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
