

Basket

Size approx. 15 x 10 cm, height 9 cm

The basket was made on a
BERNINA 1300 DC.

Materials:

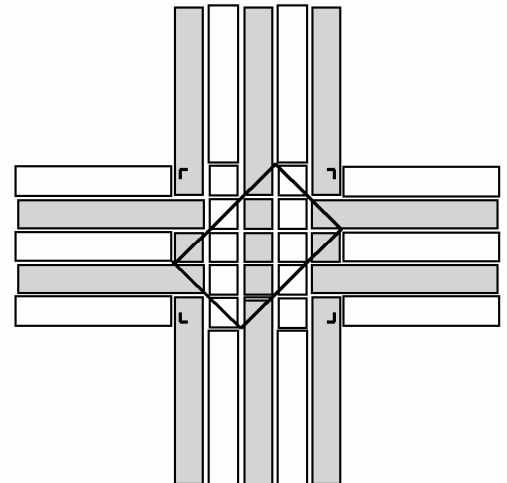
- Remnant of white cotton fabric
- Remnant or lavender cotton fabric
- Saddlecloth interfacing
- Decorative serging thread: „Glamour“ by Madeira



seam allowances here):

- 10 white strips 4 cm wide (finished width 3 cm), 35 cm long,
- 1 white strip cut on the bias, 6 cm wide, 50 cm long, for the top edge
- 2 white strips 4 cm wide, 22 cm long, for the handle
- 10 lavender strips 4 cm wide (finished width 3 cm), 35 cm long
- 10 strips of saddlecloth interfacing, 2 cm wide, 35 cm long

Instructions:

1. Iron saddlecloth interfacing to the centre of 5 white and 5 lavender strips in each case. Cover with a fabric strip of the same colour. Place all strips on the table so that the reinforced strip faces upwards.
2. Work a two-thread overlock stitch with the serger (wrapped overlock stitch with the right needle). Attach upper-looper cover. Thread decorative thread into the looper. Set knife position to about 2. Increase needle- and looper thread tension if necessary. Sew a test seam. Guide fabric strip under the serger foot and through in such a way that the needle does not touch the saddlecloth interfacing. Bind both edges. Bind the strip for the handle in the same way.
3. Place 5 strips lengthways on the table, alternating white and lavender strips. The saddlecloth interfacing is ironed onto the top fabric and forms the inside of the basket. Weave in 5 strips perpendicular to the first 5, likewise in alternating colours. The ends should stick out an equal distance on all sides. Secure the outermost corners with a few stitches.
4. With a magic pen, draw a line on two opposite sides between the 2nd and 3rd strip of fabric. Join up both ends with the opposite side into a rectangle, as shown in the drawing. Crease the saddlecloth interfacing slightly upwards along the lines. Weave each corner

- separately. To do this, overlap both of the corner strips so that they form a right angle. Continue weaving until all the strips are interwoven. Weave all corners in this way. Secure ends of tape with pins. Continue weaving until all the tapes are interwoven. Weave all corners in this way. Secure ends of strips with pins.
5. Trace a line parallel to the base, and stitch over all strips along it. Cut off ends. Pin handle to top edge. Bind top edge with the bias binding.
